1 Footpath Number SD67 :

Cllr I Seccombe has provided an update as follows: "I have had notice that Richard Barnard has requested the landowner to reinstate the path within 14 days and if this is not complied with he will issue enforcement action".

2 Wet Pour Surface No progress has been made with regard to an alternative surface.

3 Section 106 Questionnaire The Clerk has written to the school, Warwickshire County Council and Stratford District Council as agreed at the meeting of 9 November 2016. Responses will be collated and reported at February meeting.

4 Concern re Road Safety in Fulready An e-mail was sent to WCC Traffic and Safety Department on 23 November 2016 requesting that an officer meet with Cllr Hawksworth to review the situation.

5 Application for Tree Preservation Order at Ettington Chase An application was submitted and the Landscape Officer responded to say that the oak trees concerned are already subject to TPO (ref TPO/032/007 and the legal reference no. is SDC 205).

6 Abandoned Vehicles on Rogers Lane The Clerk has reported this matter to Shipston Safer Neighbourhood Team.

7 Overgrown Hedge on Rogers Lane The Clerk has yet to establish ownership of this hedge in order to write and ask that it be cut back.
