## **1 Background**

The Council made a grant to Ettington Community Speedwatch for the purchase of a Laser Gun with the request that they work with other Speedwatch groups to fund the purchase/ongoing maintenance in order to share the resource. As of January 2017 no agreement has been reached regarding shared funding arrangements.

The gun remains the property of Ettington Parish Council.

## **2 Ongoing Finance Arrangements**

Geoff Wells has reported as follows:

*I have attended training by Tele-Traffic on the correct use of our gun, accompanied by Geoff Smith (Alderminster Speedwatch), Ian Greenall (Pillerton Speedwatch) and Ian Prosser from our own group.*

*Neal Westwood of Tele-Traffic advised that we can pre-pay for the annual re-calibration service. We have agreed with both Pillerton and Alderminster that they will make pre-payments direct to Tele-Traffic for the re-calibration for the next 3 years ( December2017, 2018 & 2019) subject to confirmation.*

*Both partners will provide their own protective Hi-Viz clothing, we will loan them our signage and the gun.*

*Hopefully this resolves all outstanding issues, satisfies the conditions of the grant awarded to Pillerton and allows us all to begin hostilities.*

## **3 Action Required**

To consider, debate and make a resolution regarding the acceptability of this arrangement to the Parish Council.
